In addition to the items on the application checklist, please include the following items with your application:

1. Your Miller Analogies Test (MAT) score should be sent with this application. If your MAT score is not yet available, include with your application a report of (1) the name of the testing center where you have registered to take the test and (2) the date for which you are registered to take the test. Have the score sent to the Admissions office.
2. The essay for the DMin application is to be ten typewritten pages. The first three pages are to be autobiographical. These are followed by a one-page personality sketch of the applicant. The next two pages are to describe the applicant's vocational experience and ministry intentions. The final four pages will relate the applicant's personal view of Christian ministry. Submit one copy of the essay. This should follow the style of *Manual for Writers* by Kate L. Turabian, 8th ed.
