- Mid-America students must participate in our practical missions program which requires them to sincerely share the Gospel with at least one person per week and report it to remain in good-standing and receive their grades?

- That our students have averaged 65 professions of faith each week for over 50 years?

- Mid-America students witnessed to 5,260 people last year?

- Our faculty members publicly sign our Statement of Faith & Belief every August as part of our Founders' Days celebration?

Some schools require it when hiring faculty, but never again. This annual recognition of the necessity of faithful commitment to the precepts and truth of the Scriptures maintains our steady focus on the inerrancy and sufficiency of God's Word as revealed

in the Scriptures and is the reason we will never drift theologically.

- Mid-America now offers a Pulpit Supply Program, which provides a preacher to stand in during the absence of a regular pastor?

The church is guaranteed solid, biblical preaching, while the student preacher gains invaluable experience, proclaiming the Word and the Gospel with clarity and without compromise. In its first year, our Pulpit Supply Program (PSP) has served 16 different churches in three states, for a total of 100+ preaching engagements. PSP is also helping to bring Gospel preaching to the inmates in the Memphis City Jail.

- Mid-America students preached 2,610 sermons last year?
- Mid-America now houses two preaching libraries?

These include the 5,000-volume library of Dr. Adrian Rogers and the 25,000-volume library of Dr. David L. Allen, which is the greatest collection of preaching materials in one place and cements Mid-America as a premier school for equipping the next generation of biblical preachers.

- The College at Mid-America is now offering a new degree, the Bachelor of Arts in Communication?

- All degrees at Mid-America can be completed online (undergraduate and graduate)?
- All 39 degrees at Mid-America are fully accredited (eight undergraduate, 31 graduate)?
- 90% of Mid-America faculty members are actively involved in vocational ministry?
- Four state conventions have Mid-America alumni serving as Executive Director?
- Mid-America currently offers undergraduate degree programs at maximum security prisons in Arkansas and Colorado?

Arkansas recently had its first graduating class with 18 graduates receiving their Bachelor of Arts in Christian Studies! The Department of Corrections invites eligible inmates to participate as field ministers in the prison system to help promote moral rehabilitation within the prison where they serve.

- We offer 48 different ministry options for practical missions and community service?

- 100% of Mid-America professors have an earned doctorate?
